JEWELLERY NEWSLETTER

NOVEMBER 2011

For the past few years, I have been learning how to carve wax, which is used to cast pieces of jewellery, using the lost wax technique. Lost wax casting has been used for thousands of years to produce objects in metal which cannot be produced any other way, due to the complexity of their form. The carved wax model is embedded in a flask of plaster (investment) which is dried and heated in a kiln. The wax burns out, leaving the full negative impression of the piece. Molten metal is forced into the flask using a centrifuge. Once cooled, the flask is quenched in water, breaking the plaster and releasing the piece. Full clean up of each piece is then required. Many of you have likely seen my cast pieces, already: rings, with a strand of crochet and the Prime Collection.
